If a will belonging to the deceased was left behind, do prepare to execute the will. If not, do find a specialist or lawyer who may help you with the procedures.



CPF will send a notification to the next-of-kin on the process of withdrawing the remaining CPF from the account.



Should the deceased own a HDB that is jointly owned with their spouse, if the spouse is still alive, do report the death to HDB so that the name is striken off the deed
